Transportation and accessibility

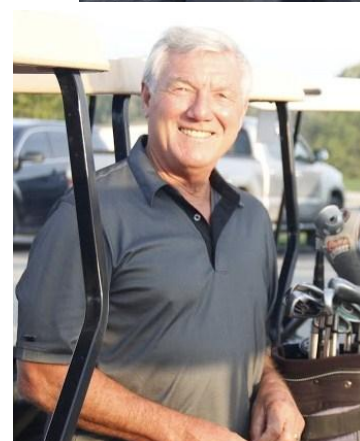

For all of us, please remember to watch out for each other and offer assistance if needed to members with restricted mobility.



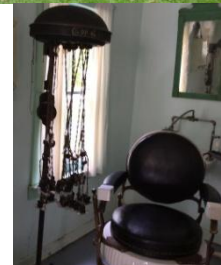
