## Transportation and accessibility

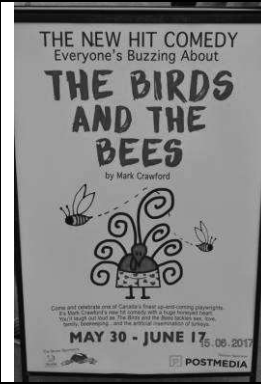

Please read the letter below to understand changes to the annuitant discount program:

To whom it may concern,

**Re: Esso employee/annuitant discount program is changing**

Please be advised that the RBC Esso Visa credit card program is being discontinued, beginning September 1, 2017. The program was not driving the expected benefits. Additional information on the cancellation of the credit card and potential replacement options is forthcoming from RBC.

The Imperial employee and annuitant discount program is currently managed through the RBC Esso Visa credit card. With the cancellation of this card, we are required to change the way the program is administered.

Imperial is continuing to provide the employee and annuitant discount to recognize the important role you all play as advocates for the Esso brand and our Retail business. Under the revised program, called the Retail Brand Ambassador Program, employees and annuitants will receive a 5¢ per litre fuel discount (to a maximum of 2,000 litres in the first year) at Esso sites in the form of a Price Privileges card. The Price Privileges cards for the Retail Brand Ambassador Program will be issued to all employees and annuitants prior to the termination of the RBC Esso Visa credit card program.

In order to provide you with your Price Privileges card we require your email address. If you have not provided an email address in Managing Your Benefits (MYB), and you wish to be a part of the Retail Brand Ambassador Program and receive the Price Privileges card, please provide/update your email address before July 31, 2017.
