Special notes concerning participation in SLEAC events

Things continue to change – we are all old enough to understand changes in our world.

Some of these changes affect how we as a group need to operate for the near future.

We will be requiring that members and guests confirm that they meet the requirement of vaccinations to be able to participate in our events. This will include being able to provide proof of being fully vaccinated.

Masks will be necessary inside except while eating or drinking.

Masks are for your own protection and out of respect for others.

We must follow the Ontario Ministry of Health guidelines as of now...

- 1. Starting September 22, 2021, each person will need to be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) and provide proof of vaccination to access certain public settings and facilities i.e., like a SLEAC event.
- 2. Each venue location that we use for an event must also follow proper Ontario Health guidelines, capacity numbers and will be monitored accordingly. We must follow the rules too.
- 3. IOL guidelines may also be issued and if there are any, we must adhere to those as well.

Therefore, at our upcoming SLEAC events, all of these conditions will impact our events and must be enforced.

Each member must use due diligence to assess their own situation and proceed with registration for an event while keeping all these parameters in mind.

We sincerely wish that everyone has a good time, that we follow the guidelines and that we respect our fellow members.

Also, when an event is planned that includes a meal, the food service will be handled according to the Lambton Health Unit guidelines.

At the Fish fry, the Optimist members will be serving each dish directly to us, table by table so there will be little touching by several hands on the spoons etc. Tables may be setup with a limit of only 4 or 6 people per table.
