EXCITING NEWS – ACCESS TO COLUMBIA EMPLOYEE STORE

We are pleased to inform you about a new perk that will be available to SLEAC members. Several times a year we will be able to shop at the Columbia Employee Store in London. This store is stocked with current season products from their family of brands that include Columbia, Mountain Hardwear, SOREL and prAna, typically at 40-50% below retail. We will receive an invitation that allows us to shop for a specified time period which will last about 3 weeks. Invited guests are allowed to bring up to 4 guests with them to shop and may visit multiple times during the invitation period. The invitations are not transferable to others.

The invites will be forwarded to club members through SLEAC and not directly from Columbia. In order to enter the store SLEAC members must bring the invitation and show photo ID. The store will verify your photo ID against a list of SLEAC members that they will have on file, therefore the name on your photo ID must be the same as the name the store has on file, otherwise you will not be allowed entry.

A list of SLEAC members will be provided to the store annually (name only, no other contact information will be provided). If the first name on your photo ID is different than the name that is associated with your IOL employee name then it is important that you let us know so we can indicate it to Columbia. For example, people who commonly use their middle name as opposed to their first name.

Please send an email to md.sleac@gmail.com indicating the name that should appear on the list we supply to Columbia.

If you are interested in participating in this promotion and receive communications from our club by post you must notify us so we can arrange to mail an invitation to you. If you do not respond we will assume you do not wish to participate in this promotion.
