Time to Renew Your Membership

Please submit your dues before June. This will enable the club to receive the corporate subsidy for your membership and for you to be eligible for membership pricing at upcoming events.

If you do not pay your dues by June you will have to pay the guest price for all events during the next club fiscal year (June 1 - May 31).

The corporate subsidy is only paid for members who have participated in at least one event during the past club fiscal year AND have paid their membership dues for the upcoming fiscal year.

This year, for your convenience, we are offering online ways for you to pay your membership dues of \$10 per person. Using the links on the SLEAC website, you can select to either E-transfer from your bank account or pay with credit card, debit card or Google Pay. You can also pay in person at the May or June events by cash or cheque, however, debit and credit cannot be accepted at the events.
