In the past few months, we have started using ETransfer for payments for SLEAC Membership and Events.

50% of membership renewals were received via ETransfer.

We have now learned the best way for SLEAC to take advantage of the ETransfer Payment Method.

First, TURN ON AUTODEPOSIT !!!

AUTODEPOSIT is much more secure than using a Password to send and receive funds.

Second, create 2 Recipients on your Online Banking


