3. *Fill in the appropriate amount for your participants.*

 - *SLEAC guest \$28*
4. *In the Message Section enter **lunch and euchre** and the **Attendees Names***
5. *Indicate if there are any dietary Restrictions.*
6. *Indicate if you require or could provide a ride to the event.*
7. *Follow instructions to complete the Etransfer.*

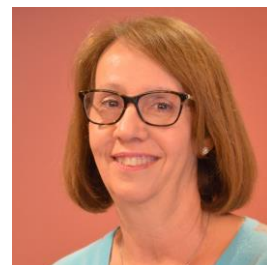
