# Impact of Subsidy Delay on the Christmas Dinner

Each year, a subsidy is provided by Imperial to support our events. The subsidy amount is calculated at \$50 for each annuitant who attended at least one event during the previous fiscal year. This allows us to subsidize events by about 40%.

For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, a total of 280 annuitants participated in at least one event, resulting in a subsidy of \$14,000.

Traditionally, we receive this subsidy in September. The funds are essential for financing the annual Christmas Event, and our planning relies heavily on the timely receipt of this financial support.

As of now, the subsidy has not yet been received. Due to this delay, we are unable to rely on the expected funds to cover the costs associated with the Christmas Event. To cover event costs, the Christmas dinner ticket price will be \$75 per annuitant. This ensures that the event can proceed as planned, despite the absence of the subsidy at this time.

We anticipate receiving the subsidy in December, which will assist with the overall financial management for future events and our organization moving forward.

Maple Apple Squares Ingredients:

- 1 Yellow cake mix
- 1 stick butter
- 1/4 c Pure Canadian Maple Syrup
- 3 or 4 Apples
- 8 oz. Sour Cream
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp Cinnamon
- Whipped Cream

#### Directions:

In bowl, place yellow cake mix and the butter (can use margarine or butter substitute). Mix these together with pastry blender until crumbly and reserve 2/3 cup in separate bowl. Pat the mixture into a 9 x 13" pan and top with thinly sliced apples. Mix together 8 oz sour cream and one egg - and spread over apples. Now take the reserved 2/3 cup mixture and add **1/4 cup maple syrup** and 1 teaspoon cinnamon and spread over the top of the sour cream layer. Bake at 350 for 25 to 30 minutes. When cool cut into squares

Serve with a wee drizzle of maple syrup and a dollop of whipped cream.

Cut into 12 squares to serve with just whipped cream.
