Transportation and accessibility





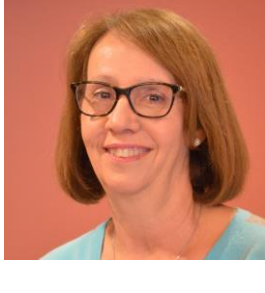

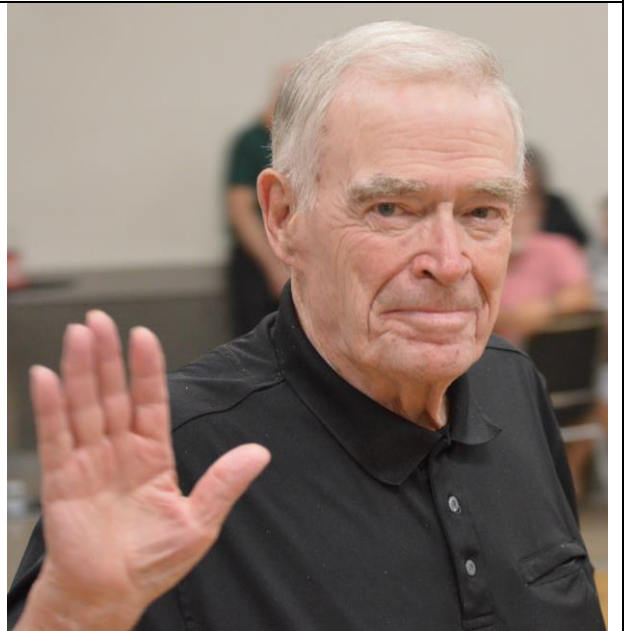

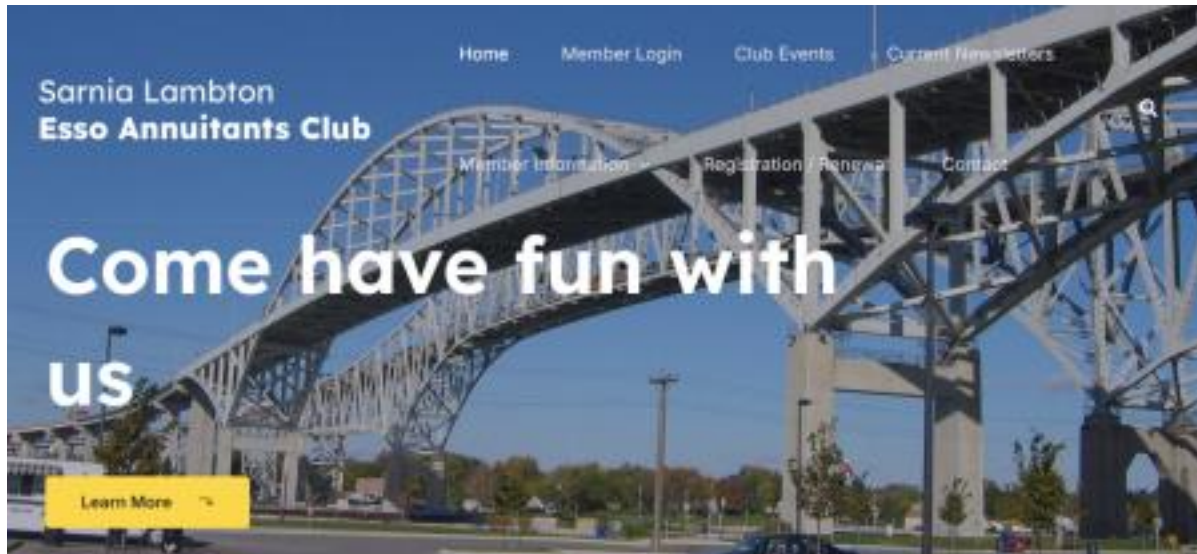
